

# Statement under the European RoHS directive RoHS (2002/95/EC) ("Restriction on Hazardous Substances")

Holland Shielding Systems B.V. certify that all products comply with the European RoHS directive as stated in RoHS (2002/95/EC)

The European Council and the European Parliament have drawn up a directive known as the RoHS directive ("Restriction on Hazardous Substances") this directive 2002/95/EC restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic components and products.

This directive for new electrical and electronic equipment connected from 1th July 2006 on the market and limits the application of the following raw materials: Lead (Pb) Mercury (Hg) Hexavalent Chromium (Cr6+) Polybrominated Biphenyl (PBB) and Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE). The maximum allowable concentrations by weight in homogeneous material as determined by the TAC (technical adaption committee) ranged from 0,01% for Cadmium and 0,1% for the other substances.
